This is a combined synopsis/solicitation for commercial items prepared in accordance with the format in FAR Subpart 12.6, as supplemented with additional information included in this notice. This announcement constitutes the only solicitation; quotes/bids are being requested and a written solicitation will not be issued.

This solicitation is being issued as a request for quotation (RFQ) under GSA Reverse Auctions ID **4399 – HP M775f Printer Toner Cartridges.**

This solicitation document and incorporated provisions and clauses are those in effect through Federal Acquisition Circular (FAC) 2005-85, effective 4 January 2016.

This solicitation is **set aside 100% to small business.** The Associated North America Industry Classification Code (NAICS) is **322230-** Office Supplies, Paper and Toner and the Business Size Standard is 500. This acquisition is in accordance with FAR Part 13. Contractor shall provide a unit price for each of the items listed in the Statement of Work. Equivalent toner manufactured by AbilityOne is required to be provided if available. The AbilityOne products are Brand Name- SKILCRAFT (registered trademark of National Industries for the Blind). The order can be “mixed”- meaning some items SKILCRAFT, some Brand Name (HP).

Delivery

Shipping shall be FOB Destination to **Communications and Electronics Command, G8, 6002 Combat Drive, 1st Floor, G8, Aberdeen Proving Ground, MD 21005.** Shipping estimated must be rounded into unit price and shall not be priced on a separate line item. Final shipping information will be included in the issued delivery order. All supplies must be delivered within 20 days after receipt of order. All prices and quotes shall be submitted in US Dollars to be considered.

Evaluation

Commercial Items. Award will be made on the basis of the lowest evaluated price of proposals meeting or exceeding the acceptability standards for non-cost factors in accordance with FAR 15.101-2. The order will be awarded to the Lowest Price Technically Acceptable (LPTA) offeror. The technical evaluation will be a determination based on information furnished by the vendor. Contractor quotes shall specifically address each requirement listed on this document and in the Statement of Work. The Government is not responsible for locating or securing any information, which is not identified within the offer. The Government reserves the right to make an award without discussions. In order to be considered technically acceptable, Contractor responses must provide:

- 1) Information in enough detail to show that the Contractor is able to meet the requirements of the Statement of Work;
- 2) Point of contact name and contact information, company CAGE code, DUNS number, and TIN.
